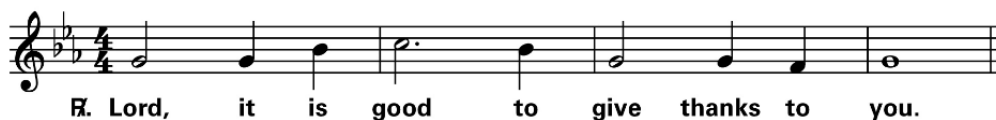
#732 Alleluia! Sing to Jesus
